



**24th Annual 2 Mile Open Water Swim
September 17, 2022**

PURPOSE: The purpose of this event is to promote Water and Boating safety and to raise funds towards an indoor swimming facility in Lexington, SC.

EVENT: 2-Mile Open Water Swim across Lake Murray at the dam. Check in / Registration is at Dominion Energy/SCE&G park in Lexington: 1888 North Lake Drive Lexington, SC. The wave starts will be from the dock on the Irmo side and the finish will be on the beach on the Lexington side and will be electronically timed for swimmers.

TIME: Swimmers Check In 7:15 – 7:45 a.m. Late Entry Registration 7:00 – 7:45 a.m. Pre Race Meeting: 8:15 a.m. Dominion Energy/SCE&G Park in Lexington. Swimmers will be checked off and load bus for transport to start on Irmo side at 8:30 a.m. Race Waves Start: 9:00 a.m.

LOCATION: Check in for event at Dominion Energy/SCE&G Park in Lexington. Required Pre Race Meeting 8:15 a.m. on beach. Swim starts will be at Lake Murray Boat Ramp on the Irmo side near Highways 6 and 60. Shuttle service for swimmers begins @ 8:30 a.m. following Pre-Race meeting. Note: **Swimmers MUST use shuttle service.**

DIRECTIONS: Dominion Energy/SCE&G Park • 1888 North Lake Drive • Lexington, SC 29072 From I-20, go north at exit 55 on South Lake Drive for 6 miles. The park entrance is on the left just before the dam.

ELIGIBILITY: Event is open to all athletes age 11 and older as of September 1, 2022.

LATE ENTRY FEES: Late Entries will be accepted the day of the event, September 17th, between 7:00 – 7:45 a.m. at Dominion Energy/SCE&G Park registration site. Late Entry fee of \$100 includes a short sleeve T-shirt, **if available**. Late entry form must be printed and brought on the day of the event with liability waiver. Check, Cash, or Credit Cards accepted at Late Entry Registration Pavilion. NOTE: **All late entry swimmers will be placed in last heat groups. No exceptions.**

SAFETY: Safety boats will monitor the entire course. Swimmers boarding a boat will not be allowed to reenter the water. If requested, kayakers have kickboards swimmers can use during event. Event ends 1.5 hours after the last wave start. Any participants remaining at that time will be picked up by boat and returned to Irmo dock. Swimmers must wear race cap and body marked with swimmer number.

AWARDS: Award will be mailed only to 1st place finishers (excluding wetsuit swimmers) in the following categories: Men's, Women's, Girls, and Boys. Awards will be mailed to participants. Race Times for swimmers will be posted on Lake Murray Dam Swim site: <https://www.lakemurraydamswim.org/> and on monitor at Finish.
